Quick Click Air Relief

The provided air relief is designed to allow air to flow into the pail to counter a fully sealed condition, reducing the potential of a pail collapse. Vacuums rated above 125" of water lift may call for a second relief if the application results in repeated or extended duration sealed conditions. While a modest volume of air will flow through the relief, it will not detract from the effectiveness of the separator or significantly reduce the performance from the vacuum.

Step-by-step Installation Guide



Drill a ½" hole in the lid of the separator bucket.



Push the threaded section of the air relief through the ½" hole with the sealing ring on the upper side of the lid.



Remove the threaded nut from the air relief.



Thread the nut onto the air relief on the underside of the lid until hand tight.
